## Joys, Concerns and Praises Pastoral Prayer, the Lord's Prayer

Scripture Lesson: Mark 11: 1-11 (8:30) Holly Gallagher (11:00) Pastor Choi

As they \*approached Jerusalem, at Bethphage and Bethany, near the Mount of Olives, He \*sent two of His disciples, <sup>2</sup> and \*said to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately as you enter it, you will find a colt tied *there*, on which no one yet has ever sat; untie it and bring it *here*. <sup>3</sup> If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' you say, 'The Lord has need of it'; and immediately he will send it back here." <sup>4</sup> They went away and found a colt tied at the door, outside in the street; and they \*untied it. <sup>5</sup> Some of the bystanders were saying to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" <sup>6</sup> They spoke to them just as Jesus had told *them*, and they gave them permission. <sup>7</sup> They \*brought the colt to Jesus and put their coats on it; and He sat on it. <sup>8</sup> And many spread their coats in the road, and others *spread* leafy branches which they had cut from the fields. <sup>9</sup> Those who went in front and those who followed were shouting:

"Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; <sup>10</sup> Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!"
