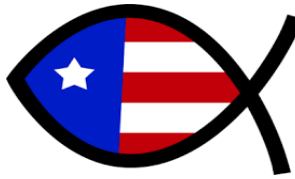

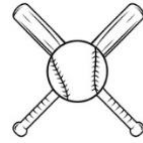
MENS'S BIBLE STUDY: is taking a short break. It will resume July 23rd, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesdays.


