- **Also, please place a \$10.00 donation inside the box for shipping.**

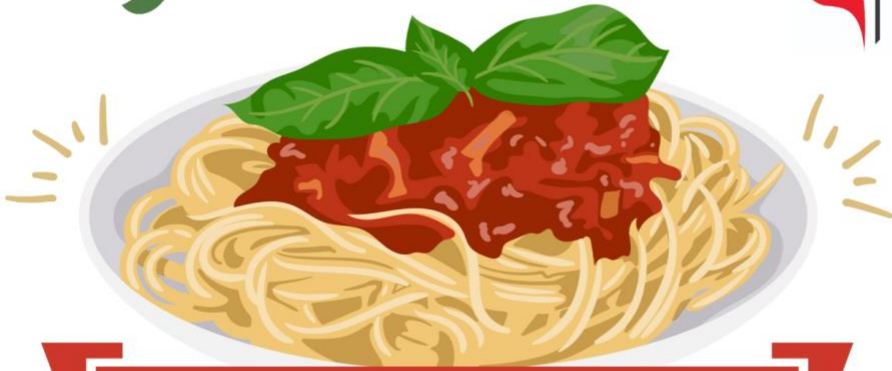
All packed boxes need to be returned by Sunday, November 23rd.
