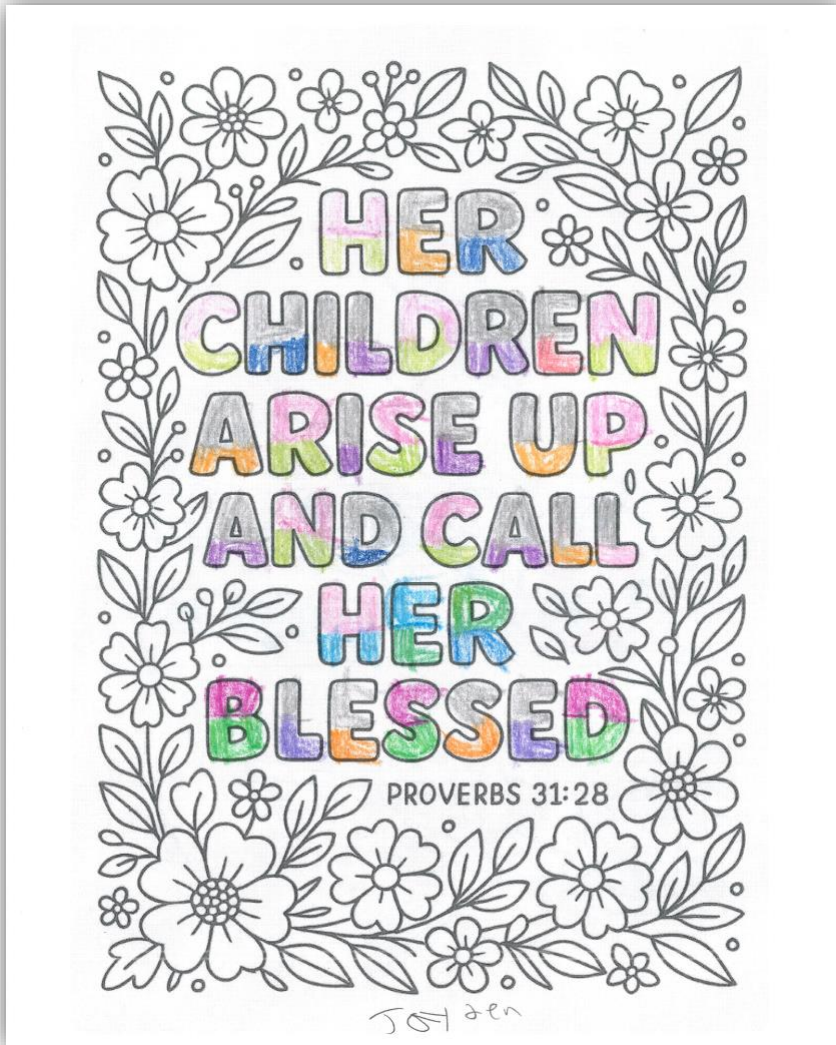

 what he says we will do, where he sends we will go;


